ACCESSING RESOURCES IN NEW HAMPSHIRE



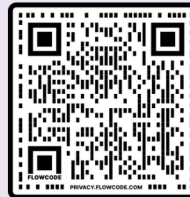
211 NH is a service that connects NH residents to the most up to date resources they need. 211 NH is staffed by specially trained Information and Referral Specialists and operates 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.



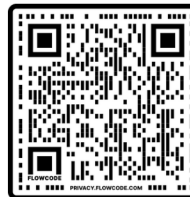
The Doorway offers assistance with accessing every level of treatment for substance use disorder. Call 211 to be connected with your Doorway, where a trained professional can help you access the level of care that's right for you.



988 is a national three-digit dialing code that connects callers to counselors who are trained to provide free and confidential emotional support and crisis counseling to people in suicidal crisis or emotional distress.



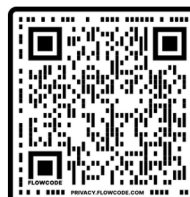
New Hampshire Rapid Response Access Point is a centralized contact point for individuals in NH experiencing a mental health and/or substance use crisis. You can call and speak to trained and caring staff who can connect you with the appropriate level of care.



The NH DHHS Recovery Support Services site provides information on recovery services for individuals and families across NH, including on peer recovery supports, recovery community organizations, pathways to recovery, family supports, recovery housing, and more.



NH Regional Public Health Networks serve as the local experts on public health resources in the community. They provide education and programming around substance use prevention, recovery, family supports, and more.
